Local Places of Worship – call your local church, synagogue, place of worship. Many times counseling services or support groups are offered there.

Local Public School – if the issue involves a child, an option may possibly be to contact your child's school counselor. You may want to call your child's school to see if their school counselor might provide that type of service.

Community Service Boards provide a variety of services in the areas of mental health, addictive diseases and developmental disabilities. Services provided vary between the various community service boards, so please call for more specific information about the particular location closest to you. Payment is based on need and they will charge based on a sliding scale. Many of the CSBs will even work out a payment plan if needed.
