




OFFENDER INTEGRATION MAP & TIMELINE

Where is the offender >>

Where is the offender? Local jail awaiting transfer to a diagnostic facility
Programs/Services Offered? N/A
What contact is permitted? Phone and/or in-person visits per facility rules

Where is the offender? Diagnostic Prison for assessment of needs
Programs/Services Offered? Health & risk assessment and reentry planning
What contact is permitted? None - outgoing emergency contact only

Where is the offender? Min - Close, County/State or Private Correctional Facility
Programs/Services Offered? Career Skills, Drug Abuse Counseling & Sex Offender Therapy, Work Detail, Mental & Medical Health Support and G.E.D. Testing
What contact is permitted? Phone, video and/or in-person visits per facility rules

Where is the offender? Transitional Center or Min - Close, County/State or Private Correctional Facility
Programs/Services Offered? Residential plans, release schedules and benefits assistance
What contact is permitted? Phone and/or in-person visits per facility rules

Visitor Tips

No tank-tops, nothing mesh or see-through; t-shirts cannot be sleeveless

Full length pants only, only children may wear shorts



No chest, shoulders or stomach exposed; no tank tops/sleeveless or see-through items

Skirts no more than 2" above knee, no stretch pants or shorts;
